By interacting with applications the way real users and attackers would, the system can uncover weaknesses that traditional scanners often miss.

"AI is dramatically accelerating how quickly software can be built, but security has become the bottleneck with over 40% of AI-generated code containing vulnerabilities," said a co-founder of zauth. "Vector finds those vulnerabilities before they turn into exploits."

Vector scans start at \$4 per test, making automated web application security testing accessible to independent developers and small teams building applications with AI.

The launch of Vector expands zauth's broader ecosystem focused on trust and security infrastructure for the emerging agentic internet. The company previously launched RepoScan, a GitHub intelligence tool that has analysed more than 17,000 repositories and logged over 430,000 user interactions, helping developers and investors identify security risks and fraudulent projects in open-source code.

zauth believes automated security testing will become a standard step before any AI-generated application goes live, helping developers move quickly without sacrificing safety.
